Soft Play Party

Please Note:

It is the responsibility of the person who is hiring the SESMA Studio and its equipment to ensure that all possible steps are taken to avoid injury or damage to the studio and equipment. Please ensure that the following Safety Instructions are followed:

- 1. A responsible adult must supervise the party equipment at all times.
- 2. Always ensure that the bouncy castle is not overcrowded; limit numbers according to the age and size of the users. Try to avoid large and small users using it at the same time.
- 3. Please ensure that the users are not pushing, colliding, fighting or behaving in a manner likely to injure or cause distress to others.
- 4. The Sumo suits have a height restriction of 5 foot. Please ensure that no one over this height uses them.
- 5. No food or drinks or chewing gum to be allowed on or near the bouncy castle.
- 6. All shoes, glasses, jewellery and badges MUST be removed before using the Bouncy Castle, crash mats, sumo suits or boxing gloves.
- 7. No face paints, party poppers, coloured streamers or silly string to be used either on or near the bouncy castle.
- 8. Climbing, hanging or sitting on the walls of the bouncy castle is DANGEROUS and must not be allowed.
- 9. If the bouncy castle is not being used for any part of the day, please switch the blower off at the mains.
- 10. Do not allow anyone to bounce on the front safety step as a user could easily bounce off the inflatable and get hurt.
- 11. Ensure that no one with a history of back or neck problems is allowed on the bouncy castle or uses the sumo suit/boxing gloves.
- 12. Do not allow anyone to be on the bouncy castle during inflation or deflation as this is DANGEROUS
- 13. No pets, toys or sharp instruments to be allowed on or near the castle.
- 14. Please ensure that users are not attempting somersaults.
- 15. Ensure that an area of 6 foot (2 metres) around the unit is completely clear.
- 16. In the event that the blower stops working, please ensure that all users get off the inflatable immediately. Check that the blower tube has not come undone or something is not obstructing the blower. In the event that it overheats, or losses power, switch the blower off at the mains then switch it back on again 1 or 2 minutes later, and it should restart.
 - If it fails to start, please speak to the member of staff in reception.

Please note that all persons using the bouncy castle, sumo suits, crash mats and any other equipment do so at their own risk.

The person(s) hiring the studio and its equipment will be responsible/liable for any damage or injury occurring from or as a result of misuse or reckless use.

These guidelines are for the safety of all people using the equipment, and it is the sole responsibility of the hirer to ensure they are fully adhered to at all times.

A member of staff checks and fills in a Health & Safety Party Check List before each party to ensure that all the equipment is safe and in working order, after which it is the responsibility of the hirer to supervise the party and the guests.

Party Party Norwich & SESMA and its staff cannot accept any responsibility for any loss of belongings or injury caused to anyone using the equipment or studio.
